SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (B)

(Peace Sunday)

John 1:35-42 - "Two of John the Baptist's disciples are led by John to Jesus, and then Jesus invites them to come and stay with him. Andrew, one of the two disciples, goes to fetch his brother Simon [Simon Peter] and brings him to Jesus, who rather solemnly renames Simon as Cephas – a name which means 'rock' The story is familiar to us, but perhaps the significance and the background of the passage have not always been clear.

There is a slightly strange emphasis on 'looking' and 'seeing' running through today's reading, which seems to indicate a moment of revelation of a vocation or mission, on the one hand, and an acceptance and response of the vocation, on the other. As with Peter, Jesus 'looks intently' at each one of us – thus communicating a personal call. Do we see and respond? *Speak, Lord, your servant is listening!* **Extracts Bible Alive Jan 2021**
