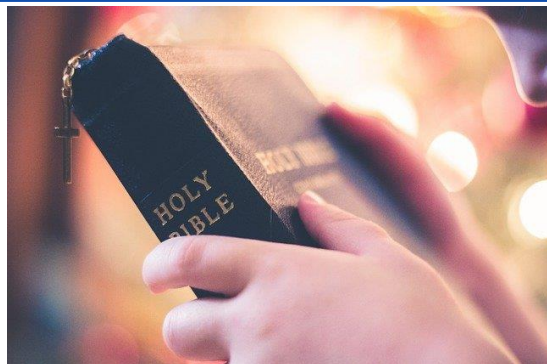
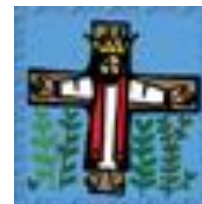

ORDINARY TIME (B)
(Sunday of The Word of God)

Mark 1:14-20 If St Mark's Gospel were a newspaper, it would be a red top, a tabloid. Mark wrote his Gospel in such a way that it grabs your attention – rather like the lead stories of a tabloid. It has pace, urgency and immediacy about it. We see this in today's Gospel, for no sooner has the Lord been tested in the desert than he is baptized in the Jordan, and no sooner has he been baptized than he sets about the task of choosing his disciples. There is no time to spare: the Lord is on a mission, there is work to do! Just as an aside, if you have never read Mark's Gospel in one sitting you should give it a try. It can be completed in just over an hour and is a fantastic read which really packs a punch!

Lord Jesus, you call each one of us to take up our cross and follow you. Grant us the grace to accept the call willingly and join ourselves to your suffering, so that we may always share in your glory. Bible Alive Jan 2021

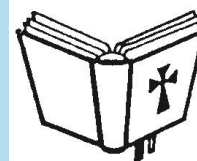

The Word of God

'Everyone should carry a small Bible or pocket edition of the Gospels and should find at least a few minutes every day to read the word of God.' (Pope Francis, 2014)
Sunday of the Word of God was established by Pope Francis in his Apostolic Letter called 'Aperuit illis' published on 30th September 2019 on the Feast of St Jerome. The event first took place on 26th January 2020. The initiative was in accordance with the Pope's intention to earmark a Sunday for the Word of God on the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time, following the Extraordinary Year of Mercy 2015 to 2016.

Pope Francis says that "A day devoted to the Bible should not be seen as a yearly event but rather a year-long event, for we urgently need to grow in our knowledge of the Scriptures and of the Risen Lord, who continues to speak his word and break bread in his community of believers."
