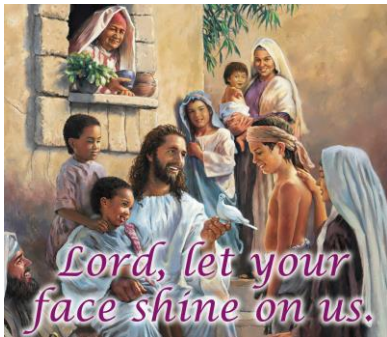

**FIRST READING:** Acts 3:13-15.17-19

**PSALM:** 4

**SECOND READING:** 1 John 2:1-5

**THE GOSPEL:** Luke 24:35-48

**Bible Alive April'21: Luke 24:35-48** "We tend to shy away from thinking, praying and talking much about heaven, eternal life and the resurrection of the body. This is an error because the Holy Spirit wants to give us wisdom and revelation into this important part of our faith, not least because the risen Christ is the principle and source of our resurrection. Expounding this truth, Paul wrote, 'Christ has been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep...For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive' (1Cor.15:20, 22). *'Lo! I tell you a mystery. We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we shall be changed.'* (1 Cor.15:51-52).
