Bible Alive May'21 John 17:11-19 "There are and have been many ordained priests but actually there is only one Priest – Jesus, the Great High priest. An ordained priest shares in this priestly ministry of Jesus, but there is only one mediator between God and man – Jesus of Nazareth, our Lord and Saviour (1 Tim. 2:5). John 17 is the high-priestly prayer of our High Priest. If you want to learn how our Priest prays, study, pray and reflect on this profound chapter from St John's Gospel. Jesus prays first for himself, then for his disciples and finally for all believers. *Lord, may we be one, united in faith and love; may we have joy flowing, flowing deep within our hearts; may we strive for holiness, sanctified by your word; and may we minister to others the riches and treasure of the Father's everlasting love.*"
