Friday 11 June is the Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus

There will be a sung mass at 8.00pm. The date also marks the 10th anniversary of the Ordination at Brentwood Cathedral of the first 7 priests of the Ordinariate ordained in the diocese. Fr David says "The mass will be offered in thanksgiving for the 1st 10 years of the Ordinariate. I hope that as many as possible will be able to be present in church. The mass will also be live streamed. Please remember those ordained 10 years ago: Fr Lee Benet, Jeff Woolnough, Fr Jon Ravensdale, Fr David Waller, Fr Rob Page, Fr Bob White and for the repose of the soul of Fr Ivor Morris." *We give thanks for our Parish Priest Fr David Waller.*
