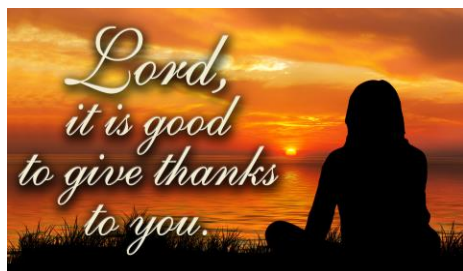

4. **JOIN the Gift Aid Scheme** www.chingfordctk.co.uk/donate/

5. **INCREASE the amount** of your bank standing order.

6. **GIVE cash and Gift Aid envelopes** if you attend Mass at the weekend, or post through Parish Office letterbox. **Collect your new Gift Aid Box** at church if in Scheme.

7. **OFFER a Mass. Fr David will say your intentions** either in public or private celebration of the Mass. **Your donation** will go towards the running costs of the parish. Thank you!
