14th December is the third Sunday of Advent and is called Gaudete Sunday, marking the mid-way point of our Holy Advent Season. The word 'Gaudete' means to 'Rejoice', and we look forward in anticipation, rejoicing that we get closer to witness afresh the mystery of our Saviour's nativity with Mary and Joseph.
