## THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD and 1<sup>st</sup> SUNDAY OF ORDINARY (2<sup>nd</sup> AFTER EPIPHANY) 11<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> January 2026



**From the 18<sup>th</sup> to the 25<sup>th</sup> of January, the Church encourages us to pray for Christian unity.** This is something strongly desired by Christ himself, as he prays for all his followers: *“that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me”* (John 17). During this time, we first give thanks to the Lord for the Ordinariate,

which is a fruit of years of prayer and dialogue for Christian unity. We also continue to pray for our separated brethren, that we may all be one in Christ.

‘O God, who dost restore them that have gone astray, gather together them that are scattered abroad, and preserve them that thou hast gathered: we beseech thee of thy mercy to pour out upon all Christian people the grace of thy communion; that, divisions being done away, they may be one flock, in one fold, under one shepherd, and do thee worthy service; through Jesus Christ our Lord.’ Amen. *A Collect for Christian Unity*
