## THE MOST HOLY TRINITY & CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY – YEAR A 31<sup>st</sup> MAY & 7<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2026



On this Sunday of Holy Trinity, we contemplate the identity of the God we worship. When we draw closer to Him, we discover that he is not an abstract idea, or a mathematical concept, but ‘the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth,’ as the Nicene Creed puts it. A living God, who is life-giving, through His Son and by His Holy Spirit, he has drawn us to have a true and intimate relationship with Him as his children. Hence, it is fitting that

Trinity Sunday is followed by the Corpus Christi (the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ), in which we are invited to receive Christ’s, or in the words of St Cyril of Alexandria, God’s own flesh and Blood, through which we participate in the Divine life. As we approach these two fundamental feasts of our Catholic faith, we can do no better than humbly marvel at the word of our Saviour when he said, *‘For the Father loves the Son and shows him all that he himself is doing. And greater works than these will he show him, so that you may marvel.’* John 5
