



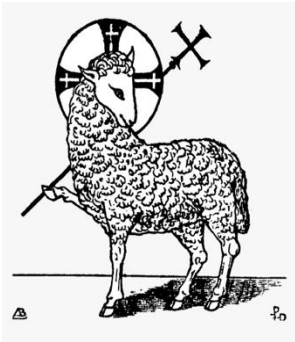

Christ says, ‘*I came that they may have life and have it abundantly.*’ I encourage everyone to take some time to read Pope Leo XIV’s first encyclical, *Magnifica Humanitas* (“Magnificent Humanity”). In this document, the Holy Father reflects on the dignity of the human person in an age increasingly shaped by technology and artificial intelligence. Drawing upon the Church’s rich social teaching, he reminds us that every person is created in the image and likeness of God and must never be treated as a mere instrument of

economic, political, or technological forces. This encyclical is not only for academics or specialists; it speaks to all of us who seek to live faithful Christian lives in a rapidly changing world. I hope that many parishioners will take the opportunity to read, pray, and reflect upon its message, allowing it to deepen our understanding of what it means to be truly human—a humanity that can only be fully realised when rooted in the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
