St Paul says that the Church is ‘*built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus himself being the cornerstone, in whom the whole structure, being joined together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord.*’

The Solemnity of Ss Peter & Paul, celebrated every year on June 29th (this year moved to Sunday, 28th), reminds us of our apostolic roots, as both Apostles were martyred and buried in Rome. As we celebrate this solemnity, let us give thanks for our apostolic origins, which continue to nurture our Catholic life, and for the Holy Father Pope Leo XIV, whose office and ministry safeguard the continued connection with

our apostolic roots.
