To restore our bell, we need to raise **£9,000**. Thanks to the generosity of parishioners and friends, we have already raised **nearly £4,000**.

To help raise the remaining funds, **Nicola Chrismas**, our senior altar server, will be undertaking an extraordinary challenge by walking a full marathon on **Sat 5th September**, following the Thames Path from **Hampton Court to the Millennium Bridge**.
